5 Biblical Principles for Money Management

1. It's Not Yours

"There was a rich man whose manager was accused of wasting his possessions" Lu 16:1

"The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it" Psalm 24:1

2. You Accountable

"Give an account of your management" Luke 16:2

3. You Need A Plan

"What shall I do now? ... I know what I'll do..." Luke 16:3-4
