INTRO QUESTION:

READ: Genesis 27:41

- What is Esau's state of mind? What is his response to what has happened with his brother?
- How did Esau get to this level of emotion?
- What would your advice be to Esau? What about Jacob?

TIPS: Pastor Ron gave three suggestions for dealing with hurt and forgiveness. He said; compassion fosters forgiveness, with God's help go first, and give others what God gives you.

- How does having compassion fosters forgiveness?
 - Does anyone have an example of how you had to see the other person as a person, before healing could happen? (please share)
- What did pastor Ron mean by, "With God's help go first?"
 - What does it do to wait for the other person to go first? How does God act with us, did He wait?
- What did God give us that we should give it to others, and what does that look like?
- If you had to pick only one to work on now which would it be?
