

## 'J'Seekers Guidelines for Families

We trust these updated guidelines will help families know what to expect when attending 'J'Seekers this Fall. Our *tentative* re-open date is Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>, with 9:00 and 10:45 Sunday services in person as well as Virtual small group options for those at home. It's our desire that each family feel comfortable re-engaging in 'J'Seekers when the time is right for you, whether in person or online. We hope you will feel ready to join us again at church soon!

- Check-In will be 'touchless' with multiple stations available upon entering the building. We ask that parents do not enter 'J'Seekers unless necessary, to limit contact with other families within the ministry area. Children will be tagged and checked in at the entrance to 'J'Seekers.
- Before entering the 'J'Seekers area, each person will have a contactless temperature check and will use hand sanitizer. Acceptable temperatures will be below 100.4 degrees.
- All 'J'Seekers staff, volunteers, and children attending will be expected to wear a face covering.
- At this time, the Nursery area (infants and toddlers) will be available for Parent use only but will not be staffed with 'J'Seekers volunteers. We will do our best to fully open the Nursery as soon as possible.
- We will limit high-touch items within the classrooms, and all areas will be sanitized between services.
- No snacks will be served in 'J'Seekers. In regards to the Preschool (2's-5's) room, please refrain from bringing any food/drink or personal items as much as possible.
- We will do our best to maintain social distancing where possible. Within the classrooms, K-5<sup>th</sup> graders will be socially distanced while seated, while the Preschool room will be partitioned to minimize interaction between the two age groups.
- Check-Out will take place at both main 'J'Seekers doors. Signs will direct parents to the appropriate door to meet their children.
