What might this tell us about God's love and reach? Have you felt like staying quiet because you don't have the correct words or prayers?
- 3. The slave girl in Acts 16:16-19 is a clear example of someone in spiritual bondage. What strikes you as odd or interesting about this story of changed life? What questions does it raise?
- 4. Read Acts 16:19-34 and discuss the Roman jailer. How did God change His life?
- 5. Take 2-3 minutes each to share one way God has changed your life. What is common in your stories? What is different? Let's encourage each other with how God is moving.
