LIFE: What is something we say in passing but we don't actually mean?

ENGAGE THE MESSAGE:

- 1. Read **James 5:16.**
- 2. Have you said "I'll pray for you" in the past? What did you mean when you said it? Was there any follow through?
- 3. Who are you praying for?
- 4. Who did Jesus pray for? Look up a few verses about Jesus praying. Matthew 19:13, Luke 23:24, John 17:9-12
- 5. In what ways are we becoming less relational as a society?
- 6. Who have you seen pray for someone in the moment?
- 7. What keeps us from praying for people out loud in the moment?

MAKE DISCIPLES: Who is God is putting on your mind to pray over? How can we encourage others to pray over others in the moment?
